A Note from Pastor Brendan...

This week we launched into the Advent Season. If you're not familiar, advent signals the time when we enter a season of preparation to celebrate Christmas – the birth and the return of Jesus.

As we look forward to Christmas, and what a New Year will bring, it's good to reflect and remember, and remind ourselves of what we've experienced and accomplished this past year. As I reflect, I could not be more proud of you, faithful family of believers. We have seen significant growth as a church in 2024, and we give all praise to God for his faithfulness to us. This year brought significant physical challenges to me that required a season of medical leave, but I was so blessed to see the way the ministry and outreach of the church continued strongly without interruption.

Here's a brief recap of how God has been honored through HCC this year. In Worship, we started the year with a call to be "Deeply Rooted". Recognizing the pressures of life that draw us away from God our Creator, Savior and Sustainer, we committed ourselves, afresh and anew, to be deep in our faith and grow in our walk with God. This series led us to the "Season of Easter", where we celebrated the Savior who Suffered for our sin, and was Raised again for our new life. Next, we embarked on a message series on "Overcoming Giants", where we went through the Bible looking at different people in Scripture and how God strengthened them to navigate the hardships in their life. After this, we entered into a sermon series on the life of "Daniel" and through his life, learned about the importance of Standing up in a Bowed down World. At the time of this writing we are in the midst of preparing our hearts to celebrate the seasons of Thanksgiving & Christmas and the Gifts God gives to us.

But that's not all! We've received 19 **new members** into the church! We've celebrated six **baptisms**! We've seen 17 **new volunteers** join the **Children's Ministry Team** in 2024, which has enabled us to grow this ministry in so many ways, including the addition of a **Wednesday Evening program** in 2025.

Our **Ministry with Teenagers** is growing both at Sunday School and Wednesday Youth Group. They are growing in the faith, growing closer in community, having fun, and bringing friends! I love to brag on the work Cherry and Adam & Tricia are doing! Each week, we're worshipping alongside **40 youth and 37 children** in these ministries. This is exciting!

A NOTE FROM CORNERSTONE MINISTRY

Jesus did not let [the man from whom he had cast out a legion of demons] come with him, but said, "Go home to your family and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you." Mark 5:19

In this verse we see a man healed and delivered by Jesus. Without hesitation, this man wanted to give all his time, energy, and attention to Jesus - to follow him wherever he went.

However, that's NOT what Jesus asked. Jesus commanded him to go home, to tell his family what had happened and of the incredible mercy of God.

Most of us have friends or loved ones who are making terrible choices, struggling with addiction, or just struggling to cope with life, and we are at a loss as to what to do for them. In this verse, it was to those people - his family - that Jesus sent this man as a born-again evangelist for Christ! The message was simple: I was lost. Jesus healed me. I'm whole and restored. Let me tell you about it.

We are all called to tell others about what the Lord has done in our lives and of God's mercy. When our clients find healing they return to their families and communities with a changed life.

Cornerstone Counseling provides counseling in partnership with In Him Christian Wellness, a non-profit Christian Counseling agency that addresses mental health from a holistic perspective. Counseling is offered using biblical principles and prayer, according to the comfort level of each client.

Services are provided to individuals, couples, families, and children, and virtual or in-person appointments are available. Cornerstone Counseling is committed to serving all clients, regardless of ability to pay. Clients need not be a member of or attend any church. Cornerstone Counseling is located at 115 Wind Hill Drive, Halifax, PA.





We've also added **3 new Adult Sunday School classes** in 2024, and we continue to build up our **Men's and Women's Ministry Groups**. Thank you to Pastor Jesse and his leadership.

In addition, we're serving food to an average of **80 people each week through our Food Room Ministry**. And we've distributed **100 Christmas Food Bags**. We continue to see **40-60 Students at the Youth Center** every school day – where we also feed them a **hot meal daily**.

We sent Missions Teams to **Uganda** and **Red Bird Kentucky** in 2024. And in addition to our ongoing Mission Work, we gave over \$10,000 to support local community **families in crisis**, including **Hurricane disaster relief** through the Global Methodist Church.

We've **completed phases 1 & 2 of our Forward in Faith Campaign** to update our Education Wings here at the church, and we completed work on the new garage — all without incurring any debt.

All this and more conveys the wonderful work God is doing right here at HCC. Your faithful giving and serving is making HCC a bright spot of Hope & Joy in our valley. You are the conduit through which God's presence is changing hearts, lives, communities, and even the world. I'm continuously delighted to see how we are making life better and YOU better through life in Jesus Christ. This is truly building our hope for tomorrow.

It is a joy to serve with you in ministry! I love you all.





Merry Christmas everyone! As we enjoy this season of expectant hope, here's just a few things to be on the lookout for in the Adult Ministry department:


