To award individual scholarships not to exceed \$2,000 ar, which award shall not be given to the same student for more than four years." "Those persons entering into the ministry would be eligible for the duration of ears of study and would be eligible for a scholarship not to exceed \$4,000 per the person receiving the ministry education scholarship must practice in the ry for five consecutive years or the scholarship will be considered a loan and must aid to the Halifax United Methodist Church (now Halifax Community Church) herein established."
